

COVID-19 STATEMENT

Due to COVID-19, remote learning commenced on March 9, 2020, for the entire school and continued through graduation on June 4, 2020. ACS did not change our grading system, and the ACS transcript reflects a year-long final letter grade. The academic year 2020-2021 began August 25 with remote learning through October 1, 2020, when ACS began reintroducing students to "on-campus" learning by grade level. Classes met for 60 minutes during remote learning. Activities including sports, clubs and service learning stopped as of March 9, 2020, and did not resume through graduation in June 2021. The academic year 2021-2022 has begun on campus and is back to the regular class schedule. Activities, including sports, clubs and service learning, are slowly returning.




