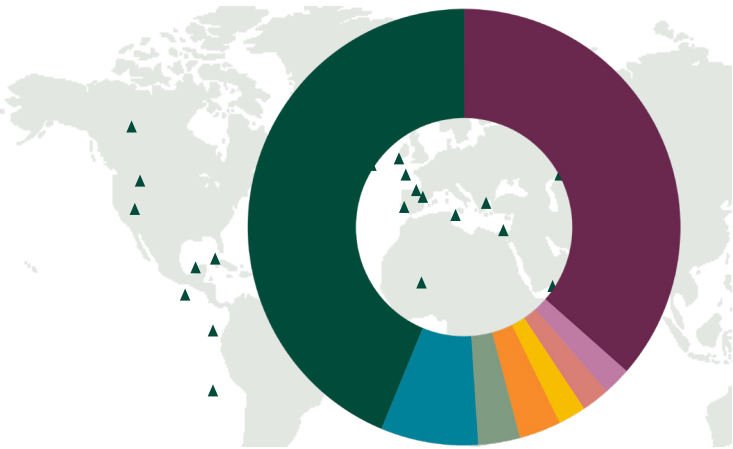

- We encourage students to enroll in no more than three HL/AP courses per school year.

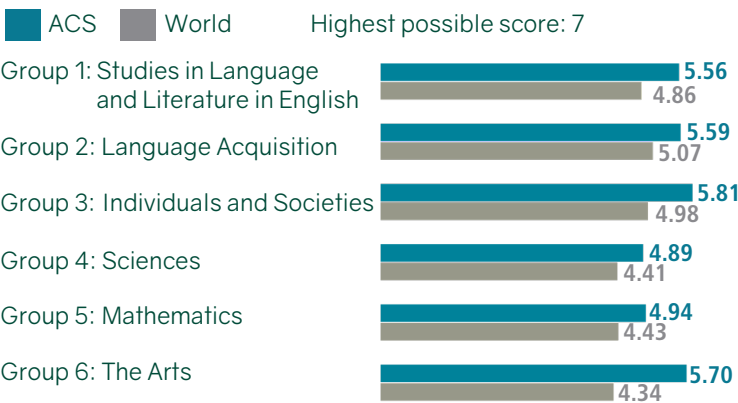

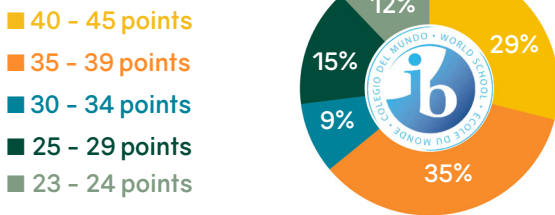

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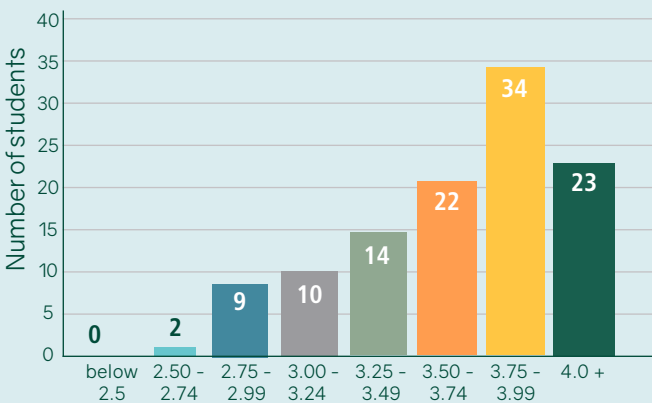
2025 AVERAGE IB SCORES BY SUBJECT
