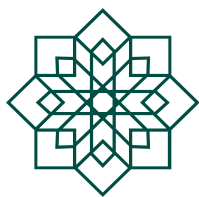

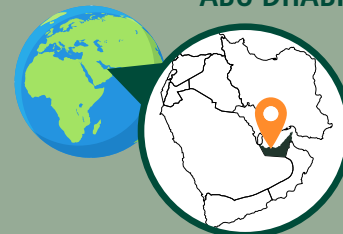
OUR SCHOOL

Established in 1972, on land donated by the late H.H. Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, the American Community School of Abu Dhabi (ACS) is a nonprofit, co-educational day school affiliated with the Office of Overseas Schools of the United States Department of State. An independent, U.S. Accredited, college preparatory school, ACS offers a comprehensive education program for 1,200 students between the ages of 4-18 representing more than 62 nationalities. **The language of instruction at ACS is English.**

COVID-19 STATEMENT

Due to COVID-19, remote learning commenced on March 9, 2020 for the entire school and continued through graduation on June 4. ACS did not change the grading system and the ACS transcript will reflect a year-long final letter grade. The academic year 2020-2021 began August 25 with remote learning through October 1, 2020 when ACS began reintroducing students to "on-campus" learning by grade level. Classes met for 60 minutes during remote learning. Activities including sports, clubs and service learning stopped as of March 9, 2020 and have not resumed to date (October 21, 2020).

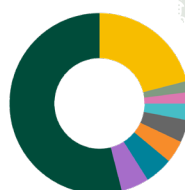

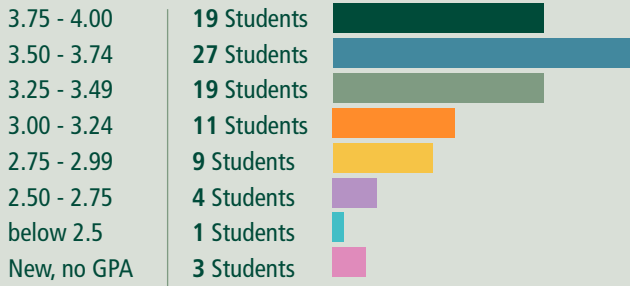
All students are required to enroll in a minimum of 7.0 credits per year.

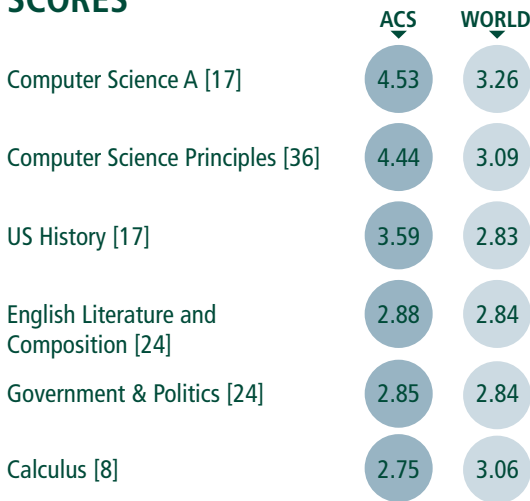


CLASS OF 2021 GPA STATISTICS

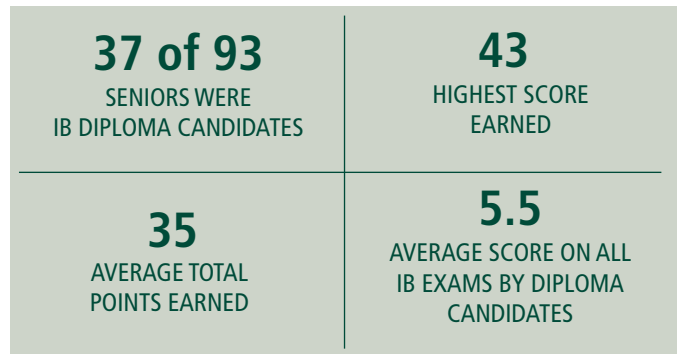
COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY APPLICATIONS

- Disciplinary infractions resulting in out-of-school suspension are disclosed to colleges and universities, if requested.

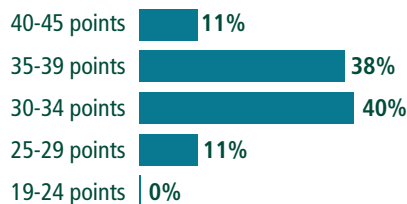
AP/IB ACCESS

- We encourage students to enroll in no more than three HL or three AP courses per school year.

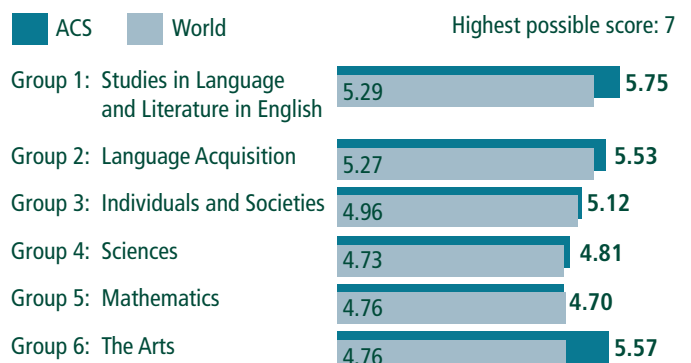
2020 INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE DP RESULTS
