- An awareness of and openness towards multiple perspectives and their place within the classroom

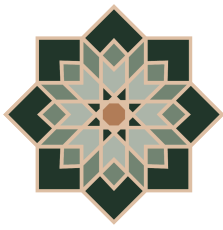
RESPONSIBILITIES:
